Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Reports (AER) which provides key information on the 2018-2019 educational progress for HCS' Alternative Education Programs: LEGACY High School and Hartland Virtual Academy. The AER addresses the complex reporting information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have questions about the AER please contact Nicole Conley for assistance.

For the 2018-2019 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given a label.

All staff members in the non-traditional programs are dedicated to working with the many rewards and challenges that come with students' educations. Our efforts can include non-academic areas of support like social emotional presentations and support groups. We always consider struggling students' confidence and the tools needed to acquire self-awareness, positive character, and life-long learning tools that are relevant for post secondary success.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

Since 1982, Hartland Consolidated Schools has offered, a non-traditional avenue, LEGACY High School, for students to earn a diploma and the district expanded its alternative education institutions in 2011 with the addition of Hartland Virtual Academy. Both programs enroll school of choice students, offer flexibility and opportunity for meaningful connection as well as post secondary planning. LEGACY delivers instruction in a standard classroom setting while HVA's primary mode of delivery is virtual. Students enrolled at LEGACY attend school daily, and HVA learners are on campus at least once a week in tutorial lab, but are encouraged and welcomed at additional sessions. Both schools have School Improvement Plans and goals are aimed at helping all students demonstrate proficiency in math, reading, writing, and social emotional learning. All students accomplish [MI Merit Curriculum standards for diploma completion](#).

Students enter the programs through an interview process. The student, administrator and parent team discuss goals for seeking alternative education programming, any issues to traditional school settings along with objectives and requirements. Flexibility and opportunity are the guiding ideologies of alternative education. Students maintain the ability to dual enroll in college, access Early Middle College openings, register with share time opportunities in conjunction with accomplishing high

school graduation requirements; curriculum documents are available on the website as well as course catalogs for the virtual classes.

Hartland Consolidated Schools, including LEGACY and HVA, has moved away from the traditional parent-teacher conference night format. In lieu of a single conference, parents have access to student performance data through our student information system on a daily basis for constant information, monitoring and school-to-home collaboration about their students' progress. Additionally, educators are available to meet throughout the year when a parent and/or the teacher requests such meetings.

LEGACY High School had 1 student participate in dual enrollment in 2018-19. Hartland Virtual Academy had 2 students participate in dual enrollment in 2018-19.

Both LEGACY High School and Hartland Virtual Academy offer two different online platforms. One platform boasts over 175 class offerings including over 30 AP courses, and the other platform provides students with just over 70 choices. In 2018-19, HVA had 2 students, or 10% of students in 12th grade, participate in AP courses.
